Community Photography Contest Entry Information

The Zelienople Area Public Library is pleased to announce the return of the Shutterbug Showdown Photography Contest featuring photographs from members of our community. We invite all library card holders in our region to participate either through submitting a photograph **OR** by stopping by the library during the show to cast your vote. Don't have a library card...plan a visit to our library and get one (it's free)!

All submissions will be judged by the Community as well as a panel of professional judges. The judges for our Shutterbug Showdown 2025 are: Andrew Barclay, 2024 People's Choice winner and local Facebook favorite; Elliott Cramer, of Elliott Cramer Photo + Video; and William Penberthy, of Penberthy Photography Studio. Submissions may be included on our website, Facebook page and/or other electronic and print communications.

Theme: This year's contest will have a theme, *The Four Seasons*, offering amateur photographers of all ages an opportunity to showcase photos that capture the beauty and diversity of our world throughout our seasons. Participants are encouraged to submit their best shots representing the unique characteristics of spring, summer, autumn, or winter.

Guidelines: This is an ALL-AGES show. Please make sure that the work you submit consists of community-friendly content. Before submitting work to this show, please consider that the library is a public space and that this show will be open to audiences ranging from children to senior citizens. While submission or participation is encouraged and appreciated, pieces containing subject matter deemed inappropriate for public exhibition may be excluded from the finals. Please consider this before finalizing your submissions and thank you for your understanding and compliance.

Judges' Input: Some thoughts from the judges:

The most important quality of a photo is its impact. Does the image:

- Immediately draw you into it and make you think?
- Tell a story that keeps you looking at it for a while?
- Elicit an emotion?

Some important key elements are:

- Overall composition with a center of interest
- Dramatic lighting
- Creative interpretation
- Color harmony
- Print quality

Prizes: *Judges' Choice* first- and second-place selections in each age group will receive a cash award. The dollar amount will depend on the number of entry fees received.

Community Choice first- and second-place winners in each age group will receive a Swag Bag of goodies from local businesses.

Applications, photographs and entry fee must be received by 6 pm on **April 30, 2025**. A maximum of two (2) photos per entrant. **Each photo submitted must be 8"x 10" in size and mounted on a foam board no larger than 11"x 14" with your name, photo number and title on the back**. Please use double-sided tape. Submitted photos should be original and previously unpublished in a commercial endeavor.

How to Vote: Each library card holder will be given two (2) complimentary vote tickets. Additional tickets are available at the Zelienople Area Public Library at 2 tickets for each donation of \$1.00. We hope you will tell your family and friends to stop by during the voting period to enjoy the display and cast a vote or two.
